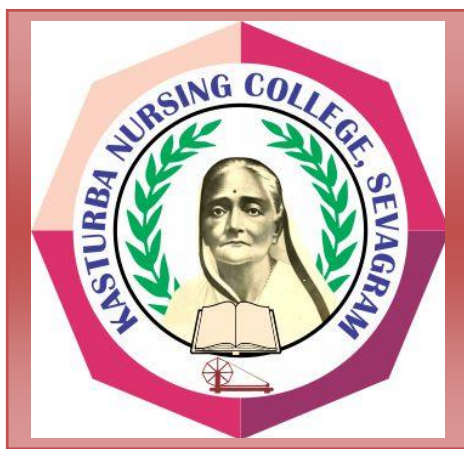

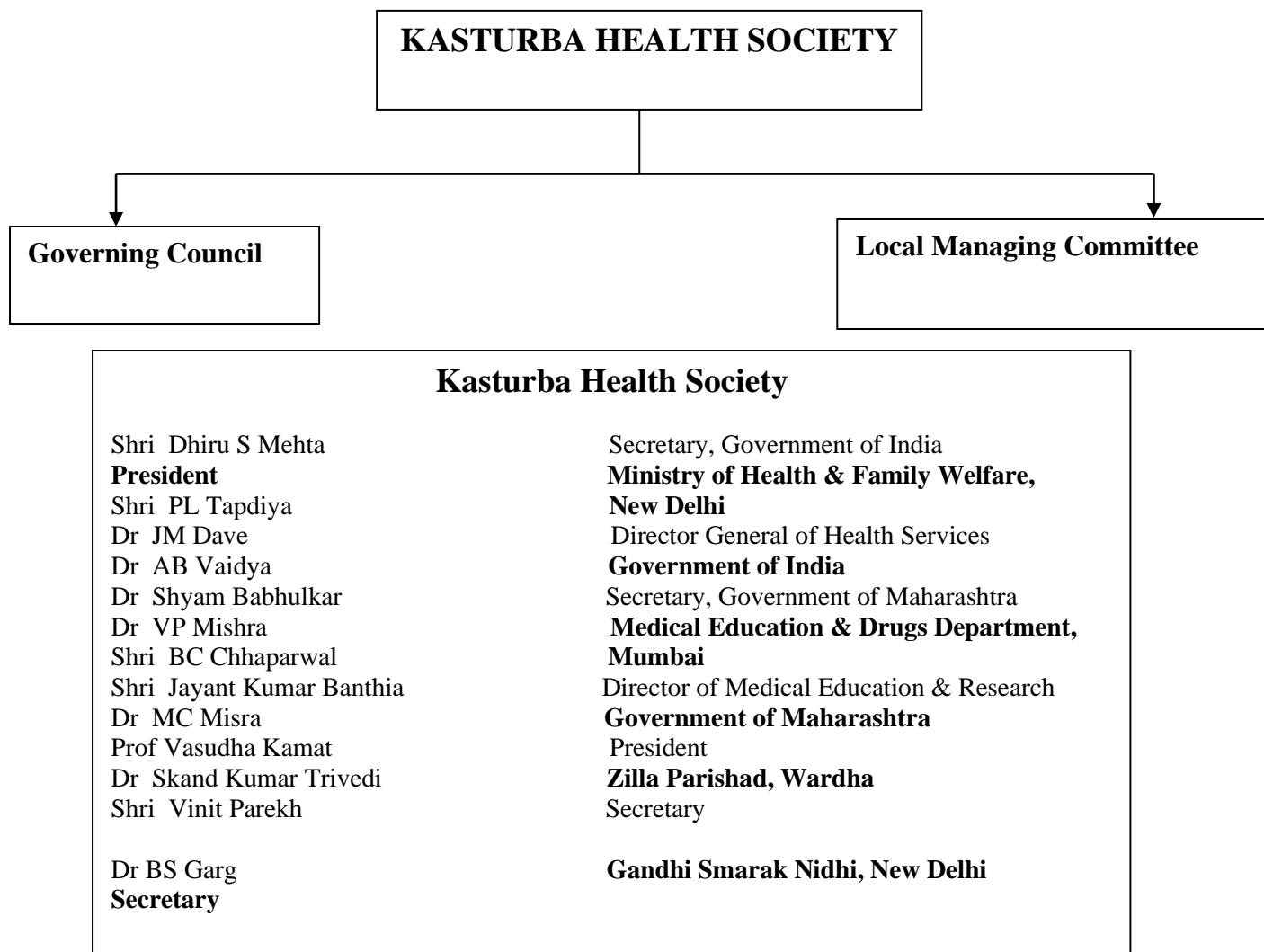

INTRODUCTION

It was the dream of Dr. Sushila Nayar to start nursing college in rural area. Kasturba Nursing College Sevagram was established in 1997. The foundation stone was laid by Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma, vice president of India on 30-12-1990 and the building was inaugurated by Hon. Former president of India Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma on 15-2-1993. Post basic B.Sc. nursing course was started in 1997 with 8 students.

PHILOSOPHY

- ◆ Kasturba Nursing College, Sevagram, affiliated to Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik subscribes to the University of which it is a part but also advocates Gandhian philosophy based on principles and philosophy of Kasturba Health Society,

Objectives

- To Prepare graduate nurses to assume responsibilities as professional, for providing promotive, preventive, curative and rehabilitative services.
- To make graduates to understand health needs and assess the health resources of our country, so that they can innovate and transform the way of delivering high quality services, primarily the health needs within the resources available.
- To prepare nurses who can make independent decisions in nursing situations, protect the rights, facilitate individuals and groups in pursuit of health, function in the hospital, community and conduct research studies in the areas of nursing practice.
- To develop the qualities in the nurses so that they will effectively and efficiently play the role of teacher, supervisor and manager in a clinical/public health setting.
- To prepare the graduates and postgraduates to assume first level positions in nursing profession, take up responsibilities such as nurse specialist consultants, educators and administrators in various professional settings.

HISTORY

Kasturba hospital started in 1944 in Sevagram and Kasturba nursing school was established in 1973. At that time there was acute shortage of nursing teachers and administrative nursing personnel. There was no nursing college in Vidarbha region. Therefore, Kasturba health society decided that nursing college should be started at our institution itself.

The enthusiasm and hard work put in by Dr. Sushila Nayar and her dedicated colleagues made it possible to start nursing college admitting the 1st batch of Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing students in 1997 with an annual intake of 10 students per year. Later in 2007 intake capacity increased to 20 students per year.

This college is 20 years old now. New courses were added to it. In 2008 Basic B.Sc. Nursing course was started with 40 annual intake and in 2011 post graduates M.Sc. Nursing started in 4 specialities. i.e. Medical surgical nursing, Community health nursing, Obstetric and gynaecological nursing and Mental health nursing with 5 students in each speciality.

Quality nursing education

The institute strives to produce nurses of high clinical competence, professional attitude and ethical behaviour. The institute believes that Gandhian Values and principles are relevant even today. We are committed to give high tech and high touch care to the needy people.

The students and staff of the institute adhere to a unique code of conduct where they are expected to wear khadi, participate in shramdan and attend all religion prayer on every Friday evening, non-vegetarian food, alcohol and tobacco are taboo.

CLINICAL EXPERIENCE AT KASTURBA HOSPITAL SEVAGRAM

Our nursing students are fortunate enough to obtain rich clinical experience in various departments of Kasturba Hospital regularly.

In 1944 when Ghandhiji returned from his last imprisonment at Agha Khan palace, Sevagram was experiencing a number of epidemic. In this situation, Bapu had no use of the guest house built for his guests by Shri. G.D. Birla. He got it converted into a dispensary, and later into a 15 bedded hospital for women and children. He put Dr. Sushila Nayar in-charge of the same. It was named “ Kasturba Hospital” in memory of Kastrurba Gandhi. Initially this hospital was run by Gandhi Smarak Nidhi. The hospital was later expanded and its services were also extended to men.

The institute primarily catered to the rural populace. Almost three-fourth of the patient to visit Kasturba Hospital came from rural background . The patient load to the hospital was not only from vidarbha in Maharashtra, but also from adjoining parts of the Andra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Chhatisgarh. Kasturba Hospital is a rural institute but it does not lack in any of the modern health care amenities and is able to provide health services at affordable cost. Kasturba Hospital offers the benefits of modern technology with compassionate health care.

The hospital has state-of- art intensive care units in Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics and Gynecology and Paediatrics which provide excellent critical care. A well equipped haemodialysis unit is available for patients of renal failure. The Shri Satya Sai accident and emergency unit provide succour to patients of trauma.

From a 15 bedded hospital the institute has gradually grown into 934 bedded one. Today Kasturba Hospital has 690 teaching beds, 100 service beds and 32 private rooms. The hospital provides 62 beds in different intensive care units (neonatal, paediatrics, medical, coronary and burn) to care critically ill patients.

Community Service

Our college is committed to serve the community. Students of Kasturba Nursing College are posted regularly in rural community areas at Anji PHC, Warud Village for rural experience. For urban experience they are posted in Urban Health Centre, Ramnagar Wardha. Further activities were carried out in rural and urban areas. School health programme was arranged in Zilla Parishad Girls School, Anji. Ten teachers and 60 female students were present. Health Education regarding personal hygiene and menstrual hygiene was given by the students of Kasturba Nursing College. Physical assessment of school students were carried out.

In Zilla Parishad Boys School, Anji. Total 06 teachers and 40 boys were present during the occasion. Health Education programmes were conducted related to tobacco chewing and smoking hazards. Physical assessment was carried out of all male students as a part of programme .

Community survey was conducted in rural areas by M.Sc Nursing First year & P.B.B.Sc final year students which covered around 200 families. In anganwadi physical assessment of 25 children was carried out.

Breastfeeding week was celebrated during August 1st -7th. Various programmes were arranged like Poster display. Skit and health education imparted. Students participated in all national health programmes and various activities carried out like skit, seminar and poster competition.

In urban area, Ram Nagar, Wardha community survey was done by the 4th year Basic BSc and P.B.BSc students around 500 families.

In rural and urban area each student assigned 5 families. They have to visit these families during their visit. They assessed the needs of the family and also as the part of the syllabus, two case studies and two care plans are to be students noted and care has to be given accordingly. Students carried out various procedures like urine and blood sugar test, TPR, dressing according to the needs of the family .

In PHC, Anji they were posted in various areas like Injection room, Pharmacy, laboratory, dressing room and they helped ANM & staff nurses in their work.

Various important health days were celebrated on National AIDS week in urban area and rural area and with the help of the social workers, rally was organized. Posters were displayed and Skit was played.

Awareness campaign was organized on tobacco day. Rally, slogan, seminar and skit were performed as a part of the campaign. 'No plastic' awareness, environmental sanitation and various online transaction methods were explained in Sevagram, Anji and Ramnagar area.

Nutritional week September (1-7) was celebrated in rural and urban area. Poster exhibition was conducted to create awareness regarding importance of nutrition in healthy life style.

Students do survey of the rural and urban population. They visit families, prepare family folders, assess the health needs of the family, impart need based care. They impart health education to the families and organize rallies for health awareness. They organise various programmes like Swaccha Bharat Abhiyan, AIDS awareness, 'no plastic' campaign, etc.

They celebrate various important days. Students organise school health programme they carry out physical assessment of school children and impart health education on various topics.

To Summarise, the students of our Institute are getting vast experience and knowledge in both rural and urban fields, apart from serving and motivating them from time to time.

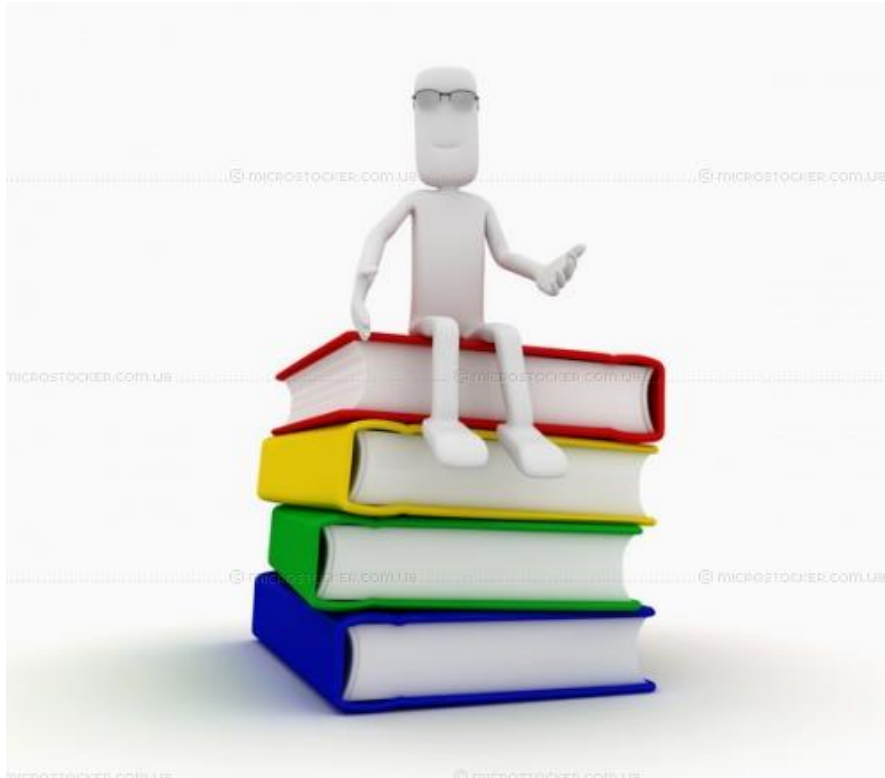
