
Message

Kasturba Nursing College : An Introduction

It was the dream of Dr. Sushila Nayar to start nursing college in rural area. Kasturba Nursing College Sevagram was established in 1997. The foundation stone was laid by Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma, Vice President of India on 30-12-1990 and the building was inaugurated by Hon. Former President of India Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma on 15-2-1993. Post basic B.Sc. nursing course was started in 1997 with an annual intake of 10 students.

History

Kasturba hospital was started in the year 1944 by (Late) Dr. Sushila Nayar and Kasturba nursing school was established in 1973. At that time there was acute shortage of nursing teachers and administrative nursing personnel. There was no nursing college in Vidarbha region. Therefore, Kasturba Health Society decided to set up Kasturba Nursing College at our institution itself.

The enthusiasm and hard work put in by Dr. Sushila Nayar and her dedicated colleagues made it possible to start nursing college admitting the 1st batch of Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing students in 1997 with an annual intake of 10 students per year. Later in 2007 intake capacity was increased to 20 students per year.

This college is 24 years old now. New courses were added to it. In 2008 Basic B.Sc. Nursing course was started with 40 annual intake and in the year 2011 M.Sc. Nursing was started in four specialities. i.e. Medical surgical nursing, Community health nursing, Obstetric and gynaecological nursing and Mental health nursing with intake of five students in each speciality.

Vision

Kasturba Nursing College aims to be the Center of academic excellence for high quality nursing education, practice and research.

Mission

The Kasturba Nursing College, Sevagram, today is committed to provide quality nursing services in terms of nursing care, education and research especially to marginalised rural community in order to discharge the social responsibilities.

- The faculty believes that nursing is an integral part of the health care delivery system and shares responsibility of working in collaboration with other allied professions for the attainment of optimum health for all members of the society.

- The Faculty believes in the development of Academic programs in Nursing based on the application of principles of model of Health sciences, including research which can help in the improvement of the quality of Nursing education and practice in India.
- Education and learning is a process of behavioural changes which are brought about by meaningful experiences within the climate of mutual respect and understanding.

Objectives

- Prepare graduate nurses to assume responsibilities as professional, for providing promotive, preventive, curative and rehabilitative services.
- Make graduates to understand health needs and assess the health resources of our country, so that they can innovate and transform the way of delivering high quality services, primarily the health needs within the resources available.
- Prepare nurses who can make independent decisions in nursing situations, protect the rights, facilitate individuals and groups in pursuit of health, function in the hospital, and community and conduct research studies in the areas of nursing practice.
- Develop the qualities in the nurses so that they will effectively and efficiently play the role of teacher, supervisor and manager in a clinical/public health setting.
- Prepare the graduates and postgraduates to assume first level positions in nursing profession, take up responsibilities such as nurse specialist consultants, educators and administrators in various professional settings.

Quality Nursing Education

The institute strives to produce nurses of high clinical competence, professional attitude and ethical behaviour. The core values of the college are based on Gandhian values and principles which are imparted to students.

We, at Kasturba Nursing College, are conscious of the fact that nursing education needs to maintain right balance between high-tech based care and companionate care in all health care settings.

Kasturba Nursing College has well equipped library, laboratories and good skill laboratory, which provide opportunity to students in enhancing their knowledge and refine their skill. Our students are trained to adhere to professional norms which include compassion, empathy, accountability and honesty.

The students and staff of the college adhere to the code of conduct of KHS – wearing khadi, participate in Shramdan and attend all-religion prayer on every Friday, abstinence from non-vegetarian food, alcohol.

Clinical Training

Students of Kasturba Nursing College obtain rich clinical experience in various departments of in the state-of-the art equipped 972 bed Kasturba Hospital. The hospital provides 62 beds in different intensive care units (neonatal, paediatrics, medical, coronary and burn unit) to care critically ill patients. A well-equipped haemodialysis unit is available for patient of renal failure. The Shri Satya Sai accident and emergency unit provide care to patients of trauma. Cardiac catheterization and surgeries are performed in Kasturba Hospital which provide excellent learning experience to students in these areas. Well equipped Palliative Care unit for terminally ill patients and patients undergoing chemotherapy.

Community Activities

Kasturba Nursing College is committed to serve the community. Students of Kasturba nursing college are posted regularly in rural community area at Anji PHC for rural experience. For urban experience they are posted in Urban Health Centre, Ramnagar Wardha. Various activities are carried out in Rural and Urban areas.

In Rural areas at Anji, school health programme was organized in Z.P.Girls school and boys school, the students of Kasturba Nursing College carried out the physical

assessment of the students they imparted Health education on various topic like harmful effect of tobacco chewing and smoking, personal hygiene and menstrual hygiene etc.

Community survey was conducted by the M.sc Nursing, P.B.B.Sc. Nursing and Final Basic BSc Nursing students in Ramnagar, Wardha .They surveyed approximately 600 families.

In P.H.C Anji they were posted in different areas like injection room, pharmacy laboratories dressing room .They rendered their services along with the staff nurses and ANM's.

In Rural and Urban area each students assigned 5 families they have to visit these families during their posting. They assessed each family member and prepare Nursing diagnosis and plan nursing care according the priority basis .Students carried out various procedure with bag technique as per the need of the family.

Students are mentored for the following activities during their placements.

1. To conduct Community health Survey
2. To screen population of all age groups for common ailments
3. To provide need based care to individual, family and community at their door step
4. To perform comprehensive family centered care to client such as antenatal, postnatal, new born babies, under five children, school aged children and adolescents.
5. To educate community about right nutrition practice for various age groups in order to address nutrition deficiency.
6. To provide health education for individuals, large and small groups based on their needs.
7. To spread awareness about various common health issues through observation of important International days (e.g. World health day, World no tobacco day, World breast feeding week, Women's day, World mental health day)
8. To perform health assessment/ screening for common health ailments for school children.
9. To participate in National health program like Pulse Polio Program, along with the Government health personnel.
10. To participate in Health camps conducted in rural health center Anji (Immunization) and (Diabetes, Hypertension, Screen for dental and ENT related issues)
11. To maintain family record for each family.

12. To identify clients who are in need of medical care and refer them to Primary Health Centres, Government Hospitals or Private Hospitals.

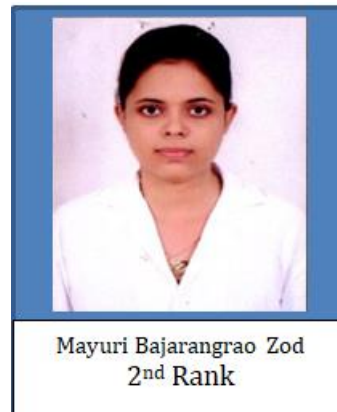

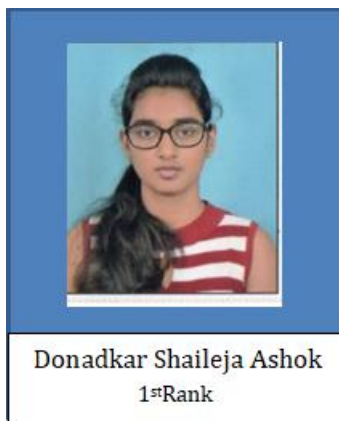

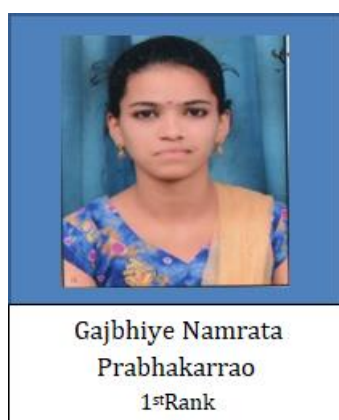

National Nodal Centre, Kasturba Nursing College, Sevagram

Kasturba Nursing College is identified as a National Nodal Centre by the Ministry of Health and family welfare, Government of India in December 2016 to conduct training programme on ‘Strengthening pre service education for nursing and Midwifery cadre in India’.

Grant received

Received grant of Rs. 23 lakhs in the financial Year 2020-2021 from National Health Mission, Government of Maharashtra, to conduct 6 weeks training on “Strengthening Pre-Service Nursing Midwifery Education” at National Nodal Centre based at Kasturba Nursing College, Sevagram, Wardha.

However, no training were conducted during this year due to Corona Pandemic.

Contribution in COVID 19 Pandemic

Faculty and students of Kasturba Nursing College are continuously rendering their services in different areas of Covid 19 Management. They contribute in patient counselling in ICU and Covid Ward, data entry of covid patients, counselling at Covid OPD, home isolation and Vaccination centers.

Our students and teachers provided nursing care and counselling to patients admitted in the hospital. They provided psychological support and provided Tele- counselling to patient's family through video call or through voice call.

Our faculty worked as a counsellor to the patient and their family in the Covid-19 OPD. They guided the patients regarding swab collection , home isolation , Covid-19 appropriate behaviour, monitoring of vital signs including monitoring of Oxygen saturation and general condition and advised them when to contact the hospital. They organize pulse oximeter to needy patients and taught them how to monitor oxygen saturation at home.

Our students and faculty is posted in the vaccination center, to help and enable the patients for pre vaccination registration. They also helped the patients in vaccination and observed the patients for any untoward effect and provided post vaccination counselling. They educated them to follow Covid-19 appropriate behaviour even though they are vaccinated.

In rural area many of the citizens are not willing to take covid-19 vaccination either due to ignorance or due to fear. Our PG students visited many of the residential area, vegetable market, bank premises and general shops to educate and motivate the public for Covid-19 appropriate behaviour & covid-19 vaccination.

Due to increased number of covid-19 cases health care team members, especially Doctors are too busy in patient care, our faculty worked as a team member in covid-19 care and helped the doctors in entering the data of the admitted patients.
